



## Te Reo Māori

### Year 7

This half year course is an opportunity for all Year 7 students to become part of growing Te Reo Māori by increasing proficiency in pronunciation. There will be opportunities to gain confidence, practise speaking phrases, reading, writing phrases and learning new vocabulary. Language activities, waiata and classroom tikanga are a part of the learning programme.

Curriculum level 1-2 Ākonga will be working between these levels depending on prior experience.

1.1 Greeting and acknowledging people.

1.2 Introduce self and others.

1.3 Communicate about number using days of the week, months and dates.

1.4 Communicate personal information such as name, parents, grandparents, pepeha.

2.4 communicate about seasons.

2.5 communicate about feelings.
